<u>Premium Events Collection™ - Presale Tickets</u>

Platinum Card® and Centurion® Members have access to purchase Premium Events Collection TM Presale Tickets for select events and select seats, during a specified period prior to the general on-sale dates for those events. Tickets must be purchased using an eligible American Express Platinum Card® or Centurion® Card. When purchasing tickets, enter the 10-digit customer service phone number on the back of your eligible Card when prompted. An American Express Prepaid Card cannot be used to purchase tickets. Must be 21 years of age or older to attend. Premium Events Collection Presale Tickets are sold by and fulfilled by third party ticket sellers (not American Express), and such tickets are subject to the rules, terms and conditions, prices and fees set by the ticket seller, event promoter and/or the venue. Premium Events Collection Presale Tickets are subject to availability and supply may be limited. Not all seats may be offered; purchase limits and blackout dates may apply. Please arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the seminar start time for seat selection. Pre-registration for a seminar does not guarantee a seat in the selected seminar(s). If you are unable to attend a seminar due to late arrival or any other reason, no refunds or make-goods will be provided.

Event Code of Conduct

Participants shall comply at all times during the Event with the Classic in Aspen Code of Conduct (currently available at https://classic.foodandwine.com/eventcodeofconduct/, subject to change at any time in Food & Wine's sole discretion).

All participants—staff, attendees, speakers, sponsors, vendors, exhibitors, and volunteers—at the Event are required to agree to and abide by this Event Code of Conduct. Cancellation Policy

Cancellations made more than 90 days prior to the event will be assessed a cancellation fee. Cancellation of Consumer and Trade passes will be assessed a \$250.00 cancellation fee that will

be applied to each pass purchased. Cancellation of Food & Wine Gives passes will be assessed a \$350.00 cancellation fee that will be applied to each pass purchased. Cancellations made within 90 days of the Event will be completely non-refundable.

Weather Policy

The Event will operate rain or shine. If the Event is cancelled for any reason, as determined by Food & Wine in its sole and absolute discretion, Food & Wine may reschedule the Event for a future date or offer a credit for a future Food & Wine Classic in Aspen.
